

Enrollment in the 2022/23 CDBG program (with proof of LHP residency and age) is required. Registration is by lottery. The deadline for the next CDBG Registration Lottery is November 30th. Please note current CDBG participants do not need to worry, this lottery deadline is for NEW participants ONLY.


