Manatee Season

It's the time of the year when manatees start making their way south toward warmer waters. Be on the lookout for these gentle creatures when boating!

Some helpful tips to avoid hitting manatees: wear polarized sunglasses, look for large circles on the surface of the water, and be sure not to exceed the posted speed limits.

You can report a manatee sighting on Broward County's mobile app, "I Spy a Manatee." Call FWC at 888-404-FWCC to report a sick, injured, or dead manatee.

Coyotes have made Florida home, yet aren't usually seen in urban areas. Recently, however, coyotes seem to be braving the traffic and other man-made obstacles to make their way to our community. Although not necessarily dangerous to humans, coyotes are known to prey on small mammals. 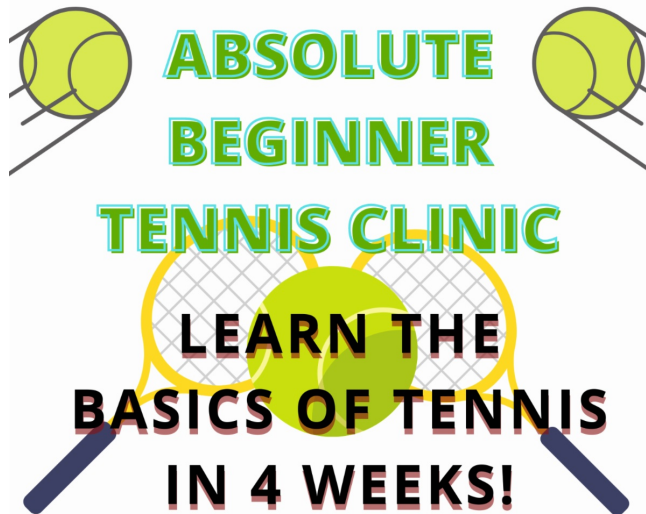

NE 38th Street Drainage Project
