

#### **NE 27th Avenue Stormwater Improvement project**

This project installs a drainage system on NE 27th Avenue from NE 33rd Street to NE 34th street. Project underway.

This project will rehabilitate the drainage system along NE 38th Street between NE 21st Way and NE 23rd Avenue and extend the system south on NE 21st Avenue. Design plans under final review
