



Residents enjoyed our City waterways as they helped clean them up on Saturday, March 4<sup>th</sup>! Thank you to everyone for their support!




## Keeper Days Awards

## Manatee Rescue

### **Pompano Reuse Irrigation Project (City of Pompano Beach)**

Single Family hookups to the system continue. Phase V design being finalized.

### **Lake Placid Neighborhood Paving Project**

This project is 95% complete. NE 27th Avenue to be completed once drainage project on Ne 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue is completed.

### **NE 27th Avenue Stormwater Improvement project**

This project installs a drainage system on NE 27th Avenue from NE 33rd Street to NE 34th street. Project underway and approximately 75% complete.

### **NE 38th Street Drainage Project**

This project will rehabilitate the drainage system along NE 38th Street between NE 21st Way and NE 23rd Avenue and extend the system south on NE 21st Avenue. Design plans under final review.
