What is MAP Broward?

MAP Broward is the 30-year program resulting from the Penny for Transportation—a one percent, transportation surtax approved by Broward County Voters in November 2018. Transportation Surtax-funded projects are intended to address the following five goals: Create Connectivity; Manage Traffic Systems; Improve Transit Service; Enhance Multimodal Options; and Ensure Economic Development and Benefits

Sample Road Improvement Project (LHP-009-010-011)

Project Limits: Sample Road from Federal Highway to the Intracoastal Waterway

Description: Feasibility Study and Preliminary Design Concepts

- Sidewalks
- ADA improvements with compatible curb ramps
- Road striping for shared access bike lanes
- Milling and resurfacing
- Stormwater and drainage modifications
- Traffic calming options & recommendations for improved safety

Now is the time to prepare for Hurricane Season!

Trim Trees and Shrubbery: Now is the time to trim trees and shrubbery, and remove coconuts. All vegetation is picked up in the City on a weekly basis. Having your property maintained before a storm will help to ensure that

our Public Works Department will be able to assist all areas of the City during unexpected emergencies. Please remember, per [City Code Section 74-33](#), all contractor-generated trash must be removed by the company generating the contractor-generated trash.

Bag It - Don't Blow It Per [City Code Section 90-39](#), no person shall throw debris of any kind, including lawn clippings or vegetation, into the canal. Both residents and hired

landscapers should bag any lawn clippings or vegetation instead of blowing them into the canal.

Dispose of Trash and Unwanted Household Items: Now is the time to get rid of unwanted items. In previous years many residents waited until a hurricane was on its way before they emptied out their garages to make room for vehicles, and unfortunately had to bring their unwanted household items and trash back into their garages because there wasn't enough time for trash collection.

Shelters or Evacuation Plan: Now is the time to form a family hurricane action plan. Lighthouse Point is a mandatory evacuation area with Category 3 and above storms. Determine what hurricane plan you and your family will follow should the need arise, how your home will be secured, and where you will stay. The best place to stay is in a home which is outside of the evacuation zone and that has hurricane shutters, food, and supplies.



The Process



SB 2500 - General Appropriations Act Approved by the Governor on June 15, 2023

The City of Lighthouse Point has a total of 5 projects that were approved in the final budget.

\$1,000,000 - Sample Road Bridge Replacement Plan
\$1,000,000 - NE 31st Court Bridge Replacement Plan
\$190,000 - NE 21st Avenue Stormwater Improvement Project
\$500,000 - Department of State 2023-2024 Library Construction Grants
\$200,000 – Tennis Center FRDAP

City Painting Project

This project will paint the insides and outsides of the Police Department, City Hall, Tennis Center and Dixon Ahl Hall as part of standard maintenance and to match the color palette of the new City buildings. Project to commence this summer.

Tennis Center Swale Maintenance

This project will excavate the tennis court clay out of the adjoining swales thereby restoring the performance of the drainage system.

NE 39th Street Paving Project

This project will mill and resurface NE 39th Street from US-1 to NE 31st Avenue. It also includes new pavement markings and turnouts to the side streets. Project to commence just after Memorial Day.

Lighthouse Drive Paving Project

This project will mill and resurface Lighthouse Drive from NE 27th Street to NE 54th Street (north city limits) including the turnouts to the side streets. Project to commence this summer.

Pompano Reuse Irrigation Project (City of Pompano Beach)


Single Family hookups to the system continue. Phase V design being finalized.

NE 38th Street Drainage Project

This project will rehabilitate the drainage system along NE 38th Street between NE 21st Way and NE 23rd Avenue and extend the system south on NE 21st Avenue. Design plans complete. Project will be constructed after the conclusion of the Library Expansion due to limited work and staging space.


