Bulk Trash Reminders

Bulk Trash and Yard Waste are collected twice a week, on the same days as your regularly scheduled household garbage collection days. Please place bulk trash/yard waste separate from your household garbage and recycling. Keep piles away from trees, limbs, overhead utility wires, fire hydrants, mailboxes, and any other objects in the area.

In accordance with Code Section 74-36, all bulk trash must remain out of the roadway and placed on the residence's lot next to the curb or roadway.



Residents may not place any recyclable materials, garbage, or bulk out for pickup prior to 3:00 p.m. the day before the scheduled pick-up. All containers must be retrieved from the curb by 9:00 p.m. the day of pick up.

Remember: Landscapers, Gardeners, and contractors must remove yard trash and clippings. Code Section 74-33 requires that all construction contractors and landscape maintenance providers dispose of all debris generated by their work.





City Painting Project

This project will paint the interior and exterior of the Police Department, City Hall, Tennis Center and Dixon Ahl Hall as part of standard maintenance and to match the color palette of the new City buildings. The painting is currently in progress with Dixon Ahl Hall complete and interior of City Hall complete.

NE 39th Street Paving Project

This project will mill and resurface NE 39th Street from US-1 to NE 31st Avenue. It also includes new pavement markings and turnouts to the side streets. The project is ongoing and will return to production once the Broward County Roadway Restoration project is complete. This project will recommence the week of 10/02/2023.

Lighthouse Drive Paving Project

This project will mill and resurface Lighthouse Drive from NE 27th Street to NE 54th Street (north city limits) including the turnouts to the side streets. Project to commence this coming Monday, 10/02/2023.

Canal Dredging Project

This project will perform maintenance dredging in select City canals. The project was approved by the City Commission on Wednesday, 09/13/2023, and final documents are being executed.

Bridge Repairs

This project will perform various repairs on eight City bridges to fortify their structures and extend their lifespans for future replacement. The project was approved by the City Commission on Wednesday, 09/13/2023, and final documents are being executed. This project will be ongoing throughout the remainder of this year and into 2024.

Pompano Reuse Irrigation Project (City of Pompano Beach)


Single Family hookups to the system continue. Phase V design being finalized and expected to begin construction in Q1, 2024.

NE 38th Street Drainage Project

This project will rehabilitate the drainage system along NE 38th Street between NE 21st Way and NE 23rd Avenue and extend the system south on NE 21st Avenue. Design plans complete. Project will be constructed after the conclusion of the Library Expansion due to limited work and staging space.
