Golf Carts



Effective 10/1/2023, House Bill 949 requires that a person operating a golf cart on a public road must:

- If 18 years of age or older, possess a form of government-issued photographic identification; or
- If under 18 years of age, possess a valid learner's driver license (accompanied by a licensed driver 21 or older) or valid driver license.

All golf carts driven on public roads must be street legal. This includes being registered with a license plate, having insurance, and being equipped with the following equipment: head lights, brake lights, tail lamps, turn signals, reflex reflectors, parking brake, rear view mirrors, windshield with a wiper, and a seatbelt for each designated seat.

Please do not drive any golf carts on the sidewalks or in the bicycle lanes.

What is MAP Broward?

MAP Broward is the 30-year program resulting from the Penny for Transportation Surtax approved by Broward County Voters in November 2018. Transportation Surtax-funded projects are intended to address the following five goals, targeting our community's challenges: Create Connectivity, Traffic System Management, Improve Transit Service, Enhance Multimodal Options, and Economic Developments and Benefits

Projects to be discussed:

Surtax funding for Sample Road Bridge Replacement (Bridge #867205)
Surtax funding for NE 31st Court Bridge Replacement (Bridge #867203)

The 2024 new Municipal Capital Project (MCP) Application period opens in February 2024. Municipalities can submit projects for consideration until March 2024. If awarded, funding will be available in 2029. According to the bridge replacement priority sequence, priority #1 is the Sample Road Bridge (#867205) over the Cap Knight Bayou and priority #2 is the NE 31st Court Bridge (#867203) over the Heron Waterway. The City of Lighthouse Point will request funding for the replacement of these two bridges.

Bulk Trash Reminders

Bulk trash and yard waste are collected twice a week, on the same days as your regularly scheduled household garbage collection days. Please place bulk trash/yard waste separate from your household garbage and recycling. Keep piles away from trees, limbs, overhead utility wires, fire hydrants, mailboxes, and any other objects in the area.

In accordance with Code Section 74-36, all bulk trash must remain out of the roadway and placed on the

residence's lot next to the curb or roadway.

Residents may not place any recyclable materials, garbage, or bulk out for pickup prior to 3:00 p.m. the day before the scheduled pick-up. All containers must be retrieved from the curb by 9:00 p.m. the day of pick up.

Remember: Landscapers, gardeners, and contractors must remove yard trash and clippings. Code Section 74-33 requires that all construction contractors and landscape maintenance providers dispose of all debris generated by their work.

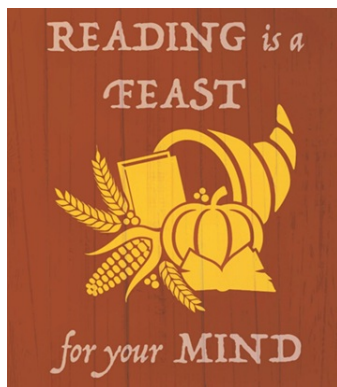

Honoring Detective Sgt. Andrew Gianino

On October 24th Sgt. Gianino was recognized by Broward County Undersheriff Nichole Anderson at the City of Pompano Beach City Commission meeting for the events that occurred on August 28, 2023. Sgt. Gianino witnessed the crash of Broward Sheriff's Office Air Rescue 85 helicopter. His extraordinary courage and swift action saved lives following the crash. As the first responder to arrive on scene, Sgt. Gianino assisted in the rescue of the surviving crew members and helped escort residents from the burning building, including a wheelchair-bound individual. Thank you, Sgt. Gianino!

NE 39th Street Paving Project

Paving for this project is complete. Temporary striping has been established with final striping to be placed after the asphalt cures for 30 days.

Lighthouse Drive Paving Project

This Project mills and resurfaces Lighthouse Drive from NE 27th Street north to the City Limits. PROJECT UPDATE: Phase 2 (Sample Road to NE 44th Street): sidestreet paving completed. Mainline milling to resume on Monday, November 6, 2023. Thank you again for your patience!

8 Bridges Repair Project

This Project will perform rehabilitative repairs on eight (8) City bridges to extend their lifespan until future replacement. A contractor has been selected and contract

documents are being finalized. The project should begin during the fourth quarter of 2023.

Canal Dredging

A contractor has been selected to perform the two tasks in Phase 1. Contract documents are complete. We expect mobilization and the project to begin during the fourth quarter of 2023.

Lift Station 224 Generator Installation

This Broward County project will complete the permanent installation of the emergency generator that has been resting on a trailer next to the station for some months. The project includes slab construction, generator installation, and landscaping. The project has been submitted for permitting and is expected to be completed by the end of 2023.

Pompano Reuse Irrigation Project (City of Pompano Beach)

This City of Pompano Beach project will install a Reuse water system in another section of the City in the Pompano Beach service area south of NE 27th Street and west of Lighthouse Drive. The project is undergoing final permitting. Estimated start date is January 2024.

FPL Storm Secure Underground Project(s)

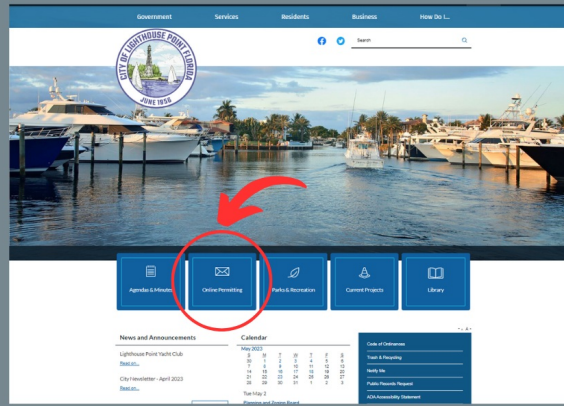
FPL has submitted power undergrounding project permit requests for the Marina neighborhood and an area north of NE 25th Street and west of Lighthouse Drive. Stay tuned for updates on project start dates and schedules.

NE 38th Street Drainage Project

This project will rehabilitate the drainage system along NE 38th Street between NE 21st Way and NE 23rd Avenue and extend the system south on NE 21st Avenue. The project is designed and permitted but in a holding pattern until the Library construction project is sufficiently complete to not be affected.
