Changes to your solid waste collection services begin the week of May 20th, with delivery of 96-gallon trash carts to your home. Beginning the week of June 3rd, new trucks equipped with automatic lifting arms will empty your carts. Note that there are no changes to pick up days, recycling, or bulk trash pick up.

Lighthouse Point Resident Automated Collection with 96-gallon Carts Coming Soon

WM is pleased to continue as your environmental services provider collecting your trash, recycling, and bulk items.

Beginning the week of May 20, a 96-gallon black trash cart will be delivered to your residence.

WM will begin its automated collection program for trash the week of June 3. Our new trucks will use automatic lifting arms to empty your cart, making collection efficient and safer for your community and our drivers.

Important Cart Information:

A 96-gallon black trash cart will be delivered to each residence beginning the week of May 20. Please DO NOT begin using your trash cart until the week of June 3.

Your collection service days WILL NOT change.

If you would like a smaller trash cart (65-gallon or 35-gallon), or a second trash cart at no charge, please email your Name, Address, and Cart preference to LighthousePoint@wm.com by May 10. If you would like a third trash cart for a fee, please contact WM Customer Experience at (954) 974-7500.



As a reminder:

- Please BAG YOUR TRASH. ALL trash must be placed INSIDE your new black cart.
- Place your cart at the edge of your driveway by 7 am, NOT in the street.
- Cart must be THREE (3) FEET from parked cars, mailboxes or fencing with cart wheels facing your home.

TO RECYCLE YOUR OLD TRASH CART, PLEASE PLACE IT CURBSIDE ON BULK COLLECTION DAY ON ITS SIDE.

There will be no changes to recycling services. Please continue to use your tan and green recycling carts. Place recycling materials loose in your recycling cart, and DO NOT bag your recyclables. Plastic bags and plastic liners are not recyclable in City recycling carts.

Three Basic Rules of Recycling



RULE 1

Recycle bottles, cans, paper and cardboard



RULE 2

Keep food and liquid out of your recycling



RULE 3

No loose plastic bags and no bagged recyclables



Now is the time to prepare for Hurricane Season

Trim Trees and Shrubbery: Now is the time to trim trees and shrubbery, and remove coconuts. All vegetation is picked up in the City on a weekly basis. Having your property maintained before a storm will help to ensure that our Public Works Department will be able to assist all areas of the City during unexpected emergencies. Please remember, per City Code Section 74-33, all contractor-generated trash must be removed by the company generating the contractor-generated trash.

Bag It - Don't Blow It Per City Code Section 90-39, no person shall throw debris of any kind, including lawn clippings or vegetation, into the canal. Both residents and hired landscapers should bag any lawn clippings or vegetation instead of blowing them into the canal.

Dispose of Trash and Unwanted Household Items: Now is the time to get rid of unwanted items. In previous years many residents waited until a hurricane was on its way before they emptied out their garages to make room for vehicles, and unfortunately had to bring their unwanted household items and trash back into their garages because there wasn't enough time for trash collection.

Shelters or Evacuation Plan: Be sure to form a family hurricane action plan. Lighthouse Point is a mandatory evacuation area with category 3 and above storms. Determine what hurricane plan you and your family will follow should the need arise, how your home will be secured, and where you will stay. The best place to stay is in a home which is outside of the evacuation zone and that has hurricane shutters, food, and supplies.



Lift Station 24D and 24D1 Rehabilitation

This Broward County project will rehabilitate the first two sewer lift stations on NE 39th Street east of Lighthouse Drive with modern electrics, pumps and pipes. The project began on Monday, 04/22/24, and may result in intermittent lane closures for materials and equipment deliveries only.

NE 39th Street Paving Project

Paving for this project is substantially complete. Final Punch List items being addressed. Thank you for your patience!

Lighthouse Drive Paving Project

This project mills and resurfaces Lighthouse Drive from NE 27th Street north to the city limits. **Project Update:** Paving is complete. Final Punch List items being addressed. Thank you again for your patience!

8 Bridges Repair Project

This project performs rehabilitative repairs on eight (8) City bridges to extend their lifespans until future replacement. NE 31st Court and NE 22nd Avenue at 44th Street bridges are complete. Sample Road, NE 48th Street and NE 49th Street are underway. Please obey the temporary traffic signals and be safe.

Canal Dredging

A contractor has been selected to perform the two tasks in Phase 1. Contract documents are complete with project commencement contingent on environmental permit receipt from the Army Corps of Engineers. Comments have been received, addressed and resubmitted. We expect mobilization and the project to begin during the second quarter of 2024.

Lift Station 224 Generator Installation

Broward County has completed the generator installation. Landscaping and equipment shading final plans have been reviewed and comments submitted. The proposed fencing and landscaping is in procurement with Broward County.

Pompano Reuse Irrigation Project (City of Pompano Beach)

This City of Pompano Beach project will install a Reuse water system in another section of the City in the Pompano Beach service area south of NE 27th Street and west of Lighthouse Drive. The project began staging on Wednesday, 04/24/24, and is estimated to take 14 weeks to complete.

FPL Storm Secure Underground Project(s)

FPL is installing conduit in the Marina neighborhood and an area north of NE 25th Street and west of Lighthouse Drive. The project continues with conduit and transformer installations.

NE 38th Street Drainage Project

This project will rehabilitate the drainage system along NE 38th Street between NE 21st Way and NE 23rd Avenue and extend the system south on NE 21st Avenue. The project is designed and permitted but in a holding pattern until the Library construction project is sufficiently complete to not be affected.

Golf Carts

Effective 10/1/2023, House Bill 949 requires that a person operating a golf cart on a public road must:

- If 18 years of age or older, possess a form of government-issued photographic identification; or
- If under 18 years of age, possess a valid learner's driver license (accompanied by a licensed driver 21 or older) or valid driver license.




All golf carts driven on public roads must be street legal. This includes being registered with a license plate, having insurance, and being equipped with the following equipment: head lights, brake lights, tail lamps, turn signals, reflex reflectors, parking brake, rear view mirrors, windshield with a wiper, and a seatbelt for each designated seat.

Please do not drive any golf carts on the sidewalks or in the bicycle lanes.
