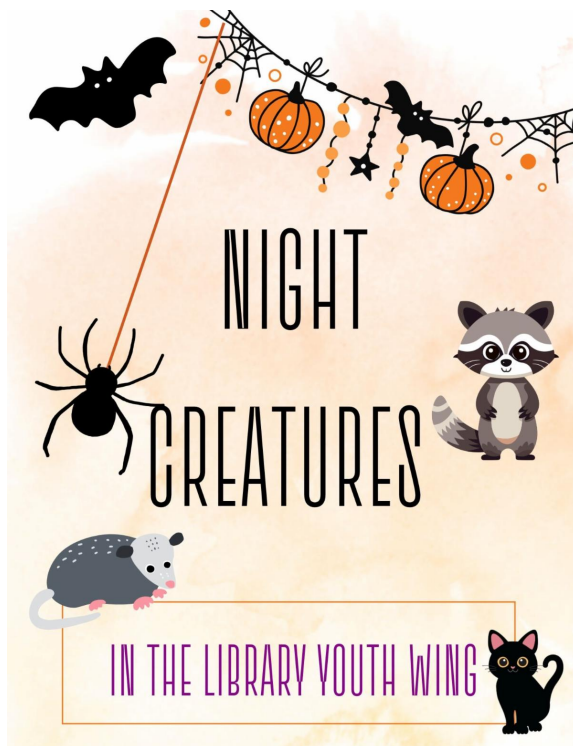

ADA Improvements Project

This project consists of ADA improvements in the City Hall lobby restrooms. The project is currently in progress and scheduled to be completed in September.

Pompano Reuse Irrigation Project (City of Pompano Beach)

The City of Pompano Beach has completed the installation of the reuse system expansion for Phase V. The system has been certified by Broward County and the individual home hookups are being scheduled. The affected roads have been repaved and striped. A punch list of asphalt corrections has been made and will be completed before project closeout.

FPL Storm Secure Underground Project(s)

The road crossings have been completed and the final house hookups are ongoing.



The City successfully completed major renovations in the Library, including the careful movement of 30,000+ books, full replacement of all shelving frames, repainting, and the installation of new carpet, countertops, and a powerful 20-ton AC system.
