Dear Residents,

Broward County Water and Wastewater Services Division (WWS) will be performing utility improvements at Master Pump Station MPS-224. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the pump station by replacing aged mechanical, electrical, and plumbing components. Construction activities include concrete repairs; replacement of existing pumps, pipes and fittings; replacement of existing electrical, instrumentation and control components; installation of an air quality control system; and landscape improvements.



LOCATION:

MPS-224 is located at the triangular-shaped median between NE 22nd Avenue, Lighthouse Drive/NE 41st Street, and the Access Road, City of Lighthouse Point.

WHEN:

November 4, 2019 thru June 30, 2020; barring unforeseen conditions or weather delays.

TRAFFIC IMPACT (see map on the back of the page):

- A portion of NE 22nd Avenue will be closed to northbound and southbound traffic, near MPS-224 Station.
- Access Road (along the south side of the station) will be closed.
- Lighthouse Drive/NE 41st Street will remain open for traffic detour.
- Access to driveways, sidewalks, and side-streets will be maintained.
